- 1. A responsible adult to escort you home. You will NOT be allowed to drive or work for the rest of that day. If you do not have someone to escort you home, you will not be offered sedation, or your procedure will be canceled and you will be responsible for the cancelation fee.
- 2. Ontario Health Card

Cancelation Fees: \$150 if less than 48 hours notice \$25 if less than 2 weeks notice

Preparation Instructions:

- 1. **Medications:** Continue on all prescription medications, <u>including</u> the day of the test, EXCEPT for:
 - a. Coumadin hold for 3 days
 - you MUST confirm with your GP or cardiologist if it is OK for you to stop this medications
 - b. Insulin if short-acting, hold morning dose
 - if 30/70 or long-acting, take half morning dose
 - c. Glyburide hold morning dose
- 2. Have nothing to eat or drink after midnight, except for your medications in the morning with a few sips of water.
- 3. If you are diabetic and feel lightheaded, then drink 1 glass of apple juice until you feel better.
